The Surprising Virtue of Complaining

## Complaining

Let's review the core of this series, Satisfied.

*Proverbs 27:20 Hell and destruction are never satisfied, and <u>never satisfied</u> are the eyes of man.* 

a. <u>The Ecclesiastes Experience</u>--Only God can meet our deepest needs. Nothing else we try will do. A deep sense of <u>loneliness</u>, <u>emptiness</u> or <u>discouragement</u> are dashboard lights, telling us our heart is trusting something other than drawing close to Christ and reflecting Him to others.

b. <u>The Job Experience-Fear</u>, <u>anger</u> and <u>depression</u> are also dashboard lights but point us to something different--a deepseated commitment to SELF, to get the "life" we think we need and deserve without having to depend on God. This is the taproot of every sin.

c. <u>The Hebrew Experience</u>- <u>Failure</u> and <u>grumbling</u> are dashboard lights that point us to (1) I'm trusting something other than Christ for my deepest needs, and (2) I'm committed to self and the "life" (feelings) I believe I need and which I deserve, without having to depend on God. The <u>entitled life</u>.

• The Whiner.

Matthew 20:11-12 They took their money and started **grumbling** against the employer.... "We put up with a whole day's work in the hot sun—yet you paid them the same as you paid us."

#### • The Martyr.

Numbers 11:11-15 Moses said to the Lord, "Why pick on me, to give me the burden of a people like this? I can't carry this nation by myself! If you're going to treat me like this, please kill me right now – it will be a kindness! Let me out of this impossible situation!"

• The <u>Cynic</u>.

Ecclesiastes 1:2-9 "Life is useless ... you spend your life working and what do you have to show for it? ...the world stays just the same... what has been done before will be done again." • The <u>Perfectionist</u>.

*Prov.* 19:13 A nagging wife is like water going drip, drip, drip on a rainy day....

*Philippians 2:14 Do everything without complaining or arguing, ...* 

### Antidotes to complaining: <u>glad</u> serving/ blessing

Philippians 2:14 Do everything without complaining or arguing, (15) <u>so that</u> you may become <u>blameless and pure</u>, <u>children of God</u> <u>without fault</u> in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like stars in the universe</u>...

Philippians 2:17 But <u>even if I am being poured out</u> like a drink offering on the sacrifice and service coming from your faith, <u>I am glad</u> and <u>rejoice</u> with all of you. <sup>18</sup> So you too should be glad and rejoice with me.
