#### Relational impact and the problem of loneliness

Luke 15:1 Now the tax collectors and "sinners" were all gathering around to hear him. <sup>2</sup> But the Pharisees ... muttered, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them."

Luke 15:28 "The older brother became angry and refused to go in. So his father went out and pleaded with him. <sup>29</sup> But he answered his father, 'Look! All these years I've been slaving for you and never disobeyed your orders. Yet you never gave me even a young goat so I could celebrate with my friends. <sup>30</sup> But when this son of yours who has squandered your property with prostitutes comes home, you kill the fattened calf for him!'

### What is Joy?

Definition #1 of joy: Certainty . Definition #2 of joy: Hunger . Definition #3: <u>Belovedness</u> .

### **<u>Re-routing</u>**:

Route to Joy #1: Shattered dreams. Route to Joy #2: Unmet longings Route to Joy #3: Brokenness.

# Reasons for loneliness:

**Loneliness #1**: <u>Substituting</u> legitimate connection for what should be our #1 connection with God.

**Loneliness #2**: Our <u>failure</u> to live up to God's standard of loving others.

Loneliness #3: The <u>inevitable</u> outcome of living in a fallen world.

Loneliness #4: Hiding the real "I" from others.

Loneliness #5: Chasing <u>illegitimate</u> connection

Loneliness #6: When others fail to connect well with me.

#### "1<sup>st</sup> thing love"

*Matthew 22:37 Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind."* <sup>38</sup> *This is the first and greatest commandment.* 

#### "2<sup>nd</sup> thing loves"

Matthew 22:39 And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'

<sup>40</sup> All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

#### **Brokenness and Beloved**

Psalm 51:6 Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward being; therefore teach me wisdom in my secret heart. <sup>7</sup> Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

*Psalm 51:8 Fill me with joy and gladness; let the bones which thou hast broken rejoice.* 

- <sup>9</sup> Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities.
- <sup>10</sup> Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me.

<sup>11</sup>Cast me not away from thy presence, and take not thy holy Spirit from me.

<sup>12</sup> Restore to me the joy of thy salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.

<sup>13</sup> Then I will teach transgressors thy ways, and sinners will return to thee.

<sup>14</sup> Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, thou God of my salvation, and my tongue will sing aloud of thy deliverance. <sup>15</sup> O Lord, open thou my lips, and my mouth shall show forth thy praise.

<sup>16</sup> For thou hast no delight in sacrifice; were I to give a burnt offering, thou wouldst not be pleased. <sup>17</sup> The sacrifice acceptable to God is a <u>broken spirit</u>; a <u>broken and contrite</u> <u>heart</u>, O God, thou wilt not despise.
