Dangers to watch out for

Danger #1: The Christian life will be easy

John 16:33 "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. <u>In this world you will have trouble</u>. But take heart! I have overcome the world."

Trouble in this life is normative.

2 Corinthians 5:7 ... we live by faith, not by sight. ⁸ We ... would prefer to be away from the body and at home with the Lord. ⁹ So we make it our goal to please him, whether we are at home in the body or away from it.

Danger #2: Being driven by feelings & pleasant circumstances

2 Corinthians 5:7 for we walk by faith, not by sight.

Danger #3: My struggle with sin is due to a lack of knowledge

Romans 7:24 What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death? ²⁵ Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!

Aspects of our "new creation"

2 Corinthians 5:17 It anyone is in Christ he <u>is a new creation</u>. The old is gone, the new has come.

"Honeymoon Christianity"

Aspect #1: a new heart

Ezekiel 36:26 "Moreover, I will give you <u>a new heart</u> and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove from you your heart of stone... and give you a heart of flesh.

Aspect #2: a new spirit.

1 Cor. 3:16 Do you not know that you are God's temple, and that God's Spirit lives in you?

Ezekiel 36:26 "Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; ...

Aspect #3: a new purity.

Isaiah 1:18 Come now, let us settle the matter," says the Lord. "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like lamb's wool.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins He is faithful to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Jeremiah 33:8 <u>I will cleanse them from all the guilt of their sin</u> they have committed against me and will forgive all their sins of rebellion against me. ⁹ Then this city will bring me renown, joy, praise and honor before all nations on earth...

Aspect #4: a new power.

Ezekiel 36:27 "I will put My Spirit within you and <u>cause</u> <u>you</u> to walk in My statutes, and you will <u>be careful to</u> <u>observe</u> My ordinances.

Isaiah 42:6 I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people and a light for the Gentiles, ⁷ to open eyes that are blind, to free captives from prison and to release from the dungeon those who sit in darkness.

Aspect #5: a new <u>identity</u> (God's child; God's family; wanted),

■ Galatians 4:4 But when the set time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, ⁵ to redeem those under the law, that we might receive <u>adoption</u> to <u>sonship</u>. ^{e 6} Because you <u>are</u> his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "<u>Abba</u>, <u>Father</u>." ⁷ So you are no longer a slave, but <u>God's child</u>; and since you are his child, God has made you also an <u>heir</u>.

Aspect #6: a new disposition; new inclinations.

Colossians 1:9 We continually ask God to fill you with <u>the knowledge of his will</u> through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives, ^{t 10} so <u>that you may live</u>

a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God.

The being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience...

Aspect #7: New <u>purposes</u>.

■ Phil 3:10 I want to know Christ—yes, to know the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death.

2 Corinthians 5:15 And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.

Aspect #8: A new <u>life</u> in you and through you

John 1:4 In him was life, and that life was the light of all man.

John 10:10 ... I came that they may have life, life abundantly.

So What?

1. Sense of wonder.

Prov. 4:23 Guard your heart with all vigilance, for out of it flows the springs of life.

2. I'm free, not chained.

John 8:31 If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. ³² Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.... ³⁴ ...everyone who sins is a slave to sin.

3. Armed to meet the realities of this world.

Psalm 18:32 It is God who arms me with strength and keeps my way secure.
